



WSSEF Registration Instructions for Students in the Following Counties: Snohomish and King

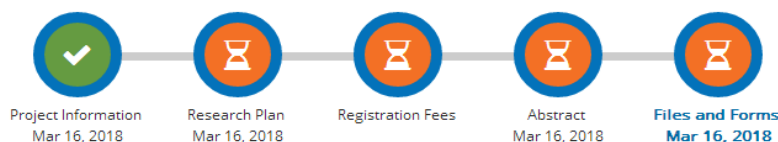
Students in Grades 1 – 8

To register for the WSSEF, click on wssef.stemwizard.com.

Helpful hint on the STEM Wizard page, click on the top right "Registration" link and then "Student Registration" from the drop down menu to begin your registration process.

Enter the required student information, complete all registration milestone steps and pay your entry fee of \$30 per person. Each team member pays their own \$30 registration fee.

WSSEF Registration Milestones: You are finished with the WSSEF registration process and can consider yourself registered if your milestones are either green or orange with an hourglass as shown below.



Students in Grades 9 – 12

You are required to register and attend the Central Sound Regional Science & Engineering Fair (CSRSEF) or to request a waiver from the CSRSEF Fair Director at <https://centralsoundfair.org/> before attending the WSSEF.

DO NOT create a duplicate registration at WSSEF! The CSRSEF Fair Director will upload your information and files to WSSEF. Once completed, you can log into your account to verify your WSSEF requirements are fulfilled.

**** Every student** is required to pay an entry fee of \$30 per person to WSSEF. Each team member pays their own \$30 registration fee. Note: WSSEF registration fees are required separately from CSRSEF fair entry fees.
