



WSSEF Registration Instructions for Students in the Following Counties:

Students in Grades 1 – 5

To register for the WSSEF, click on wssef.stemwizard.com.

Helpful hint on the STEM Wizard page, click on the top right "Registration" link and then "Student Registration" from the drop down menu to begin your registration process.

Enter the required student information, complete all registration milestone steps and pay your entry fee of \$30 per person.

WSSEF Registration Milestones: You are finished with the WSSEF registration process and can consider yourself registered if your milestones are either green or orange with an hourglass as shown below.



Students in Grades 6 – 12

You are **required** to register and attend the Mid-Columbia Science Fair (MCSF) or to request a waiver from the MCSF Fair Director at director@midcolumbiasciencefair.org before attending the WSSEF.

After attending the Mid-Columbia Science Fair (MCSF), contact your MCSF Fair Director to automatically upload your information and files for your WSSEF registration. Your user name and password will work for both Fairs.

Do Not create a duplicate registration at WSSEF! The MCSF Fair Director will upload your information and files to WSSEF. Once completed, you can log into your account to verify your WSSEF requirements are fulfilled.

Pay your entry fee of \$30 per person.

Note: WSSEF registration fees are required separately from your MCSF fair entry fees.
