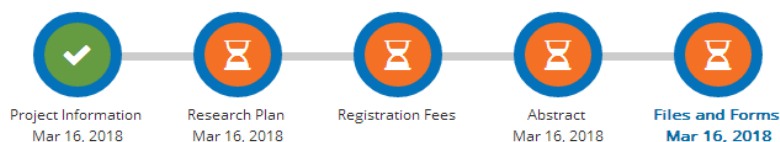
Students in Grades 1 – 5

To register, go to WSSEF registration at wssef.stemwizard.com and follow the steps:

Use the buttons at the top of the page to register as a student or sign-in to your account.

Enter the required student information and click on the milestones to complete your registration and pay your entry fees of \$20 per person or each team member.

WSSEF Registration Milestones: You are finished with the WSSEF registration process and can consider yourself registered if your milestones are either green or orange with an hourglass as shown below.



Students in Grades 6 – 12

You are ***required*** to attend the Mid-Columbia Regional Science & Engineering Fair or to request a waiver from the Regional Fair Director. www.midcolumbiasciencefair.org

After completing the Mid-Columbia Regional Science & Engineering Fair (MCRSEF) registration, contact your Regional Fair Director to automatically upload your MCRSEF registration to the Washington State Science & Engineering Fair (WSSEF). Your user name and password will work for both Fairs.

Pay your entry fee of \$20 per person or each team member. (Note: WSSEF registration fees are required separately from your regional fair entry fees.)

Review your required student information by clicking on each milestone to complete your registration.
