



Registration Instructions for Students in the Following Counties:

Pierce, Thurston, Mason and Lewis

Planning to Attend the Washington State Science & Engineering Fair (WSSEF)

Students in Grades 1 – 12

You are required to register and attend the South Sound Regional Science & Engineering Fair (SSRSEF) or to request a waiver from the SSRSEF Fair Director at www.plu.edu/scifair before attending the WSSEF.

To register for the WSSEF, click on wssef.stemwizard.com.

IMPORTANT: WSSEF registration deadline is March 15 and before the South Sound Fair Day. You can register at WSSEF prior to the South Sound Fair Day as long as you attend the South Sound Fair or get a waiver.

Helpful hint on the STEM Wizard page, click on the top right "Registration" link and then "Student Registration" from the drop down menu to begin your registration process.

Pay your entry fee of \$30 per person. Each team member pays their own \$30 registration fee.
Note: WSSEF registration fees are required separately from your CSRSEF fair entry fees.

WSSEF Registration Milestones: You are finished with the WSSEF registration process and can consider yourself registered if your milestones are either green or orange with an hourglass as shown below.
