A high-school WSSEF student earned Best in the World – Earth and Planetary Sciences. Her prizes also included a trip to CERN Large Hadron Collider in Switzerland. Another student was featured in Popular Science magazine as one of the top 10 high school students nationwide with truly world-changing ideas backed by functioning prototypes.
